

## **South Dakota LWML Mission Trip to Rosebud Indian Reservation**

June 20-24, 2010, the South Dakota LWML is planning a Mission Trip to Rosebud, South Dakota, a great opportunity to learn more about our SD LCMS work among our Native American South Dakotans.

The main purpose of the trip will be to help Pastor Andrew Utecht with the VBS program that week. Participants will be helping the VBS students do crafts and other projects. Those attending will also be helping with a rummage give-away and organization of the food pantry. Participants need to have a willing attitude toward these brothers and sisters in Christ. Items for the free rummage need to be in 'great shape'. If you would not use it or have your grandchildren use it, let's not give it to our family in Christ.

The approximate cost for lodging and meals will be about \$350-\$450 per person, based on a group of 12.

Participants will be asked to help provide the craft items for the VBS. Pastor suggested we plan for about 25 students.

This mission trip is open to LWML'ers, their spouses and also young adults 14 or older if accompanied by **their** parent.

We need to have a group of approximately 6-to 12 to successfully do the work needed that week. If there are less than six people, the trip will be cancelled.
