Meals (see registration form)

Registration for the meals is located on the registration form. Meals for the convention will consist of Friday evening meal, Saturday breakfast and Saturday lunch.

Hotel Reservations

You are responsible for making your own hotel reservations. Rooms have been blocked at the Crossroads Hotel and Huron Events Center. Everyone is encouraged to stay at the Crossroads. They are being very generous with the use of their events center. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Zone Banners
