**Biblical Manuscripts**

For the first 1400 years of the Christian church, the Bible wasn't printed, but written out by hand. What do these handwritten Biblical manuscripts look like, what problems do those pose for our faith, what insights can we learn by studying them, and how have they influenced Christian artwork?

**Jesus' Identity in the Gospel of Mark**

Join Pastor Koch in exploring the various characters of the Gospel according to Mark and who they understood Jesus to be. See how their perceptions of Jesus can inform our own perceptions of Jesus, to the end that we can boldly confess Jesus to be the Christ the Son of God.

**Prayer: Rooted in the Gospel**
