Water Outreach has three elements: assembling and distributing a water purification system, health and hygiene education, and evangelism. Teams of 8-20 people will transform communities by providing families with a sustainable water purification system, information on how to use the system and the reasons for its use, and a clear culturally-appropriate Gospel presentation. This is a great long-term project that has the possibility of changing entire communities by providing them with clean water, good health habits and proper sanitation. A Team Leader will be assigned to prepare, train, and lead the team on this mission.

PASSPORT & VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS:

Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the team's return date to the United States. If this requirement is not met, you may be refused re-entry into the country. Please visit the U.S. Department of State (travel.state.gov) for additional information.

There are no required vaccinations to visit Guatemala. To view which vaccinations are recommended, visit cdc.gov/travel. Please consult with your doctor before getting any vaccinations. As of 10/3/2022, there are no COVID entry requirements.
